

Federal Air Transport Agency of Russia extended the regime of temporary flight restrictions until June 24, 2022

Rosaviatsia once again extended the ban on flights to airports in the south of Russia

The Federal Air Transport Agency has extended the temporary restriction of flights to the airports of Anapa, Belgorod, Bryansk, Voronezh, Gelendzhik, Krasnodar, Kursk, Lipetsk, Rostov-on-Don, Simferopol and Elista until 03:45 Moscow time on June 24, 2022.

The rest of the country's airports are operating normally, [according](#) to the department. As an alternative, the Federal Air Transport Agency previously proposed using the airports of Sochi, Volgograd, Mineralnye Vody, Stavropol and Moscow.
